
Oltorf Street Reconstruction Project

Project Information

The City of Austin Public Works Department is planning street reconstruction and utility improvements for Oltorf Street from Congress Avenue to the south-bound IH 35 access road. Improvements for this project include:

- Full depth street reconstruction
- Repair or replacement of curbs, gutters, bus pads, and driveways within the City right-of-way
- Improvements to sidewalks
- Improvements to existing water and storm drain lines
- Installation of new 12 inch waterline
- Improvements to traffic and signal equipment



Project Construction

Construction is scheduled to begin in spring 2011, and last approximately 14 months. During construction residents and businesses can expect lane closures, detours, noise, heavy equipment in the area, and construction dust. One lane in each direction will remain open at all times. Regular construction hours will be Monday - Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
