

These photos were taken the day after a June 2002 rain event. It had stopped raining but water was still running from the higher St. Edward's elevations northbound to St. Edward's Drive and flowing over the street.





Note that in some of these photos the cars are swerving to avoid deep water in the road.





Water had gotten so deep across the road near the phone box that the COA came out and put up barricades.



The genesis of the water is from the culvert created by the raised elevation of the baseball field. Runoff from the higher elevations is channeled through this area onto St. Ed's Dr.



Water pools at St. Edward's Drive and crosses the road into the neighborhood.
