## Issues brought up during walkabout:

- Elmhurst access to I-35; odd access road
- Need cohesive sidewalks and bike lanes
- Parker Lane
  - Noisy speeding cars; accidents have occurred at two homes possibly due to drunk drivers
  - Cars squeezing by to pass on the right when other cars are trying to turn left off of Parker (at Windoak, Mariposa, Fawn and Deerfield)
- Parker Lane between Deerfield & Parker
  - o Graffiti on backyard fences
- Parker/Woodland: police patrols needed on Saturday evenings
- SW corner of Parker Ln. & Woodland
  - Stop sign obstructed by tree branches not visible to drivers approaching Parker from West.
  - o PM rush hour cars squeeze by on Woodland to pass on right to turn south onto Parker, driving over curb & lawn
  - Increased signage needed on approach to flashing red light; slow down warning sign around Matagorda needed
- IH-35 & Woodland Avenue
  - Northbound I-35 access road to Woodland Ave: overgrown weeds under I-35 impede drivers' view when turning onto Woodland from I-35
  - This corner on both east and west sides is becoming a favorite for panhandlers
  - Homeless men camping under interstate and lack of street lighting under bridge
- Drainage issues
  - o SW corner of Parker Ln. & Woodland



- Storm water empties out from a pipe and forces water down alley between
   Old E. Riverside Rd. and Lupine to the north and south and between Summit and Upland to the east and west.
- In cul-de-sac at Manlove & Inglewood there is no storm water runoff management
- IH-35 & Woodland –Sidewalks needed:
  - o On Woodland east of I-35
  - o On Summit between Woodland & Riverside
- Traffic calming
  - o Along Summit
  - o Parker (Windoak to Woodland)
  - o On section of Woodland approaching flashing light at Parker from the west
- Connection to hike and bike trail needed (I-35 & Riverside area)
- Old E. Riverside Rd. popular area for transients
- At Summit & Riverside there needs to be a crosswalk
- At Windoak & Matagorda (on the mansion property where the pond is located) this might be a good future neighborhood park site.
